The Shelton House

49 Shelton St, Waynesville 28786

Located next door to the Farmers Market, The Shelton House was built in 1875 and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Housed in and around the Shelton House, the Museum of North Carolina Handicrafts features comprehensive exhibits of 19th century crafts. This is also one of the featured stops on the Haywood County Quilt Trails.

Explore The Haywood County Quilt Trail

Pick up a Quilt Trail Guide at Shelton House or the Haywood County Visitor Center, and start exploring the unique patterned blocks that are scattered throughout the county. The quilt trail helps Haywood County tell its history by featuring colorful and meaningful quilt squares installed on barns, public buildings, and shops around the community. Spend the rest of the afternoon visiting and learning the stories of the many quilt blocks throughout our bustling towns and peaceful rural communities.
