- Santa Holiday Farm Tours at Winchester Creek Farm: From the day after Thanksgiving to
 Christmas Eve, families can spend a day meeting and learning about the farm's many alpacas
 while taking in the beautiful Christmas decorations. Guests can share their wish lists with Santa,
 who will be on site handing out special gifts. Treats like sugar cookies and locally-made candy
 canes will surely satisfy any sweet-tooth cravings.
- Canton Christmas Parade: Kick-off the holiday season at the Canton Christmas Parade which will feature dance teams, local businesses, vintage cars and high school bands marching the downtown streets of Canton on Dec. 7. Mr. and Mrs. Clause will be making a special appearance at this community favorite.
- A Night Before Christmas: On Dec. 16, the streets of downtown Waynesville will come alive with hundreds of luminaries lining the sidewalks, trees decorated with twinkling balls and lamp posts wrapped in red ribbon and garland. During this annual holiday tradition, there will be carolers, live music and old-fashioned wagon rides. Visitors can discover handcrafted goods from downtown shops, explore local art galleries and savor culinary delights from the many eateries.
